**No. 35.**—Under the provisions of section 24 of the (Lower Burma Land and Revenue Act, 1876, the Local Government is pleased to fix the rates set out in the subjoined Schedule A as the *maximum* rates at which land revenue shall be assessed according to the assessment tracts and classification adopted by the Settlement Officer on lands subject to that Act, cultivated with the crops specified in Schedule A, and situated in the *kwins* of the *Myaungmya* District named in Schedule B, and to declare that the said rates shall remain in force for a period of twenty years from the 1st July 1921 to the 30th June 1941 save and except in tracts 28 and 29 for which the period shall be ten years.

No. 102.—In exercise of the power conferred by section 23 of the Lower Burma Town and Village Lands Act, 1898, and with the previous sanction of the Local Government, the Financial Commissioner prescribes the rates set out in the subjoined schedule as the maximum rates at which land revenue shall, subject to the provisions of section 23 of the said Act and with effect from the 1st July 1921, be assessed according to the classification adopted by the Settlement Officer on land of the classes specified and situated within the limits of the Towns of the Myaungmya District named in the schedule. The Financial Commissioner's Notification No. 68 of the 3rd May 1912 in so far as it affects the towns mentioned in the schedule, is hereby superseded.
